Add Tarquin to the mix and things start to get complicated.

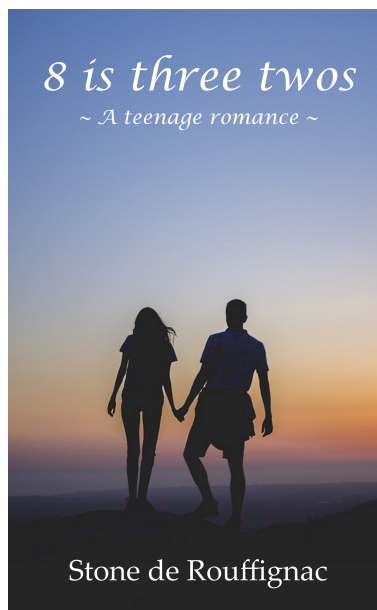
